TumbleBook Cloud Jr:

Browse our collection of videos and chapter books that include read-alongs, graphic novels, and audio books suitable for elementary grades.

Bookflix:

Find classic fictional video storybooks from Weston Woods, as well as nonfiction e-books from Scholastic, suitable for PreK–3rd grade. E-Books from Scholarly Presses

Very Short Introductions:

Browse the entire catalog of Oxford University Press's series. The books in this platform offer concise overviews to a range of academic subjects.

University Press Scholarship Online:

Find full text of more than 7,000 academic monographs from six leading university presses.

Project Muse:

Find full-text access to top quality book-length scholarship and peer-reviewed scholarly journals in the humanities and social sciences.

Sage:

Search the full catalog of Sage Publishing's social science ebook platform.

Digital Collections:

Digital Collections provides free access to more than 700,000 digitized items from the holdings of The New York Public Library, with new items added every day.


HathiTrust:

Getting a NYPL Library Card

There are two ways to get a library card with NYPL. Create a digital library card when you download the SimplyE app from your appstore.

- Open app.
- Tap “find your library.”
- Select New York Public Library.
- Go to settings by tapping the three lines.
- Select “Accounts” and “New York Public Library.”
- Tap “Sign Up.”
- Follow prompts, the app will recognize you are in NY state and will not work if you are in another state.
- When you tap “Create Card” make sure to write down your username, barcode and pin. They will disappear and not be available again.
- Open catalog and you are ready to “get” or “reserve” titles.

OR

Fill out the application linked below for a NYPL Library Card. The library card will be mailed within 4 weeks to the address you provide. If you live, work, go to school or pay taxes in New York State, you are eligible for a NYPL Library Card.

OverDrive:
Browse a large selection of e-books, audiobooks, and video, for use with a wide variety of e-readers, portable devices, PCs, and Macs.

Cloud Library:
Explore a growing selection of e-books, for use with the iPhone, iPad, iPod Touch, Android products, and Windows PCs.

Flipster Digital Magazines:

Get free access to more than 100 popular magazines, including Bon Appetit, Seventeen, Time, and English and Spanish editions of People.

AudioBookCloud:

Listen to audio books in many different categories, including fiction, nonfiction, and classics. These books are always available, never on hold, and do not need to be downloaded.

BARD (Braille & Audio Reading Download):

If you have a visual impairment, physical print disability, or dyslexia, become a member of the Andrew Heiskell Library to get free access to the BARD collection of e-audiobooks, e-audio magazines, and electronic braille.

Bookshare:

If you have a print disability, sign up for Bookshare, a service where books are read aloud by the synthetic voice of your computer or mobile device, while also displaying highlighted text.

TumbleBooks:

Enjoy animated talking picture books, story books, puzzles, and games, or find audiobooks and books in other languages.
