- Find a book in your home you have not read yet and read it. :)
- Listen to an audiobook using [Overdrive](#) or [Libby](#)
- [Join](#) or create a virtual book discussion (online or via email)
- Try something new! Read something you normally would not/outside your comfort zone
- Read a book from your TBR (To Be Read) list
- Recommend a book you love to someone (family, Facebook friend, neighbor over a fence...)
- Watch a movie or tv series based on a book
- Post what you are reading using [#stayathomereadingchallenge](#) or [#stayathomereadabook](#)
- Visit an author's website (try searching for them, looking on [Goodreads](#), or going to their publisher's website) and join their mailing list, or email them a question or comment
- Download and read a book from your library using [Overdrive](#) or [Libby](#)
- Read something (a poem, paragraph, prayer) aloud to yourself, family, or even a pet!
- Eat something that reminds you of a book (e.g. tea & scones with an Agatha Christie mystery)
- Free Choice - Do anything book or library related!
- Start or use your [Goodreads](#) account to rate a book you've read
- Read a book someone has recommended to you
- Read at least 3 articles from a newspaper or magazine (bonus if they DO NOT mention Covid-19)
- Re-read a classic or old favorite (classic ebooks available for free at <https://www.gutenberg.org/>)
- Try [Novelist](#) to find books or authors you might like to read
- Email webster.reference@libraryweb.org the title, author or genre of your favorite comfort read
- Listen to an interview with an author (try <https://www.npr.org/sections/author-interviews/> or Professional Book Nerds interviews in Overdrive or at <https://professionalbooknerds.com/>)
- Read a cookbook; more than just one recipe ;)
- Email or post a selfie of you reading, so we can see the title (see hashtags above)
- Read a book from the [Great American Read](#)
- Watch a book trailer (search [youtube.com](https://www.youtube.com) for book trailers)
- Settle down with a book over 400 pages; you have time ;)
