

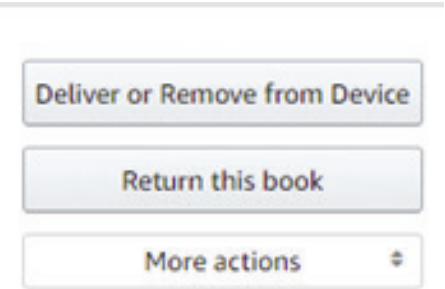
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1. Overview

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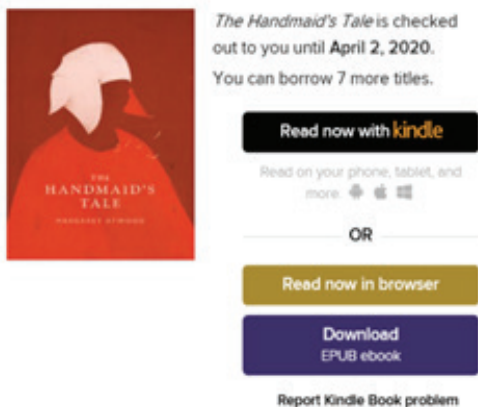
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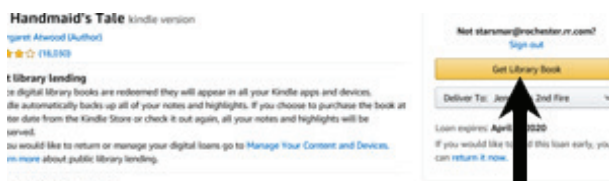
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Connect your Kindle to your computer. Copy the ebook from your downloads folder to the "documents" folder on your Kindle. The ebook will then appear on your Kindle's home screen.



4. Reading an Ebook

Tap the right side of the screen to move forward through the text. Tap the left side of the screen to move backward. For older Kindles, use the arrow buttons.

The options menu can be accessed by tapping on the center of the screen. From the options menu you can advance to different chapters of the book, change the font size, save bookmarks, and return to the "Bookshelf" view by hitting the back arrow. On older Kindles, use your menu button or arrow keys to select the menu.

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
